
LONE FIR CEMETERY, PORTLAND OREGON: NAMES OF PERSONS BURIED IN LONE FIR CEMETERY WHO WERE SENT OVER FROM DR. HAWTHORNE'S INSANE ASYLUM

In 1864, Dr. J. C. Hawthorne built the "Oregon Hospital for the Insane." It was located on a large plot of land in the southern portion of East Portland, Oregon bounded by 9th Avenue on the west, 12th Avenue on the east, Taylor on the north, and Madison on the south. "U" Street, the southernmost street in the East Portland townsite, was renamed "Asylum Avenue." In 1888, this street was changed to Hawthorne, in honor of Dr. Hawthorne. The Oregon Hospital for the Insane served as the state asylum until 1883 when the State Hospital for the Insane was opened in 1883.

The hospital held a large number of patients. On 1 June 1880, the Federal census taker found 280 patients lodged in the institution. Most were classified as insane while a small minority were termed "Idiotic." The ages for the patients ranged from nine to seventy with the majority in their thirties. Dr. G. E. Nottage was the resident physician and lived on the grounds with his wife and three year old son.

From 1867 to 1879, the hospital contracted with Lone Fir Cemetery to bury the bodies of those patients who were not claimed by their relatives. The fee for burial was \$5.00. This was the standard grave-digging fee for that time period.

Most of the records for removals from the Insane Asylum to Lone Fir are located in the University of Oregon Special Collections Divison. (Collection Number B147). The names of those listed and their date of death begins on the next page.
