III. Narrative: On the above date and time while working as the Utility II Deputy, inmate Chassic was brought to MCDL to be booked in. Deputies Hubert, Hollenbeck, and McElhanev went out to the police Sallyport to help assist the Tri-met officers. Inmate Chassic was carried to the ISO-1 cell in the booking area, by the Tri-met police and the Deputies. Inmate Chassic entered the booking area in handcuffs, spit sock around his head and nylon hobbles around his legs. In the sep-cell I was told to get scissors so they could cut off

The hobble. Chassie's shoes were taken off, and they smelled so bad that I placed them in a property bag and sealed them up. Once the restraints were removed medical was notified to check on Inmate Chassie. Medical refused to book Chassie into MEDC. The Tri-met officers said they were going to take Inmate Chassie to the Hospital to be observed. Chassie was placed back into restraints. As he was being carried out, Chassie was kicking his legs and yelling all the way to the police car. Tri-met police left MEDC without further incident.
