8 While on patrol, Sgt O'KEEFE notified me that Officer Humphreys and Deputy Burton had been in disturbance call assisting Central precinct. Sgt. O'KEEFE told me that Deputy Burton had drive-stun the suspect during the struggle.

I head out to NW 13th / NW EVERETT in order to find out more information about the TASING incident involving the two TRANSIT OFFICERS. I checked my MDT and noticed that the officers had left the scene, and that they were enroute to the Jail.

I stopped by Central Precinct and I saw Officer Humphreys and Deputy Burton for about a minute or two while they were enroute to the P.A Hospital after the Jail had refused to take Tasing prisoner in. Both officer told me that SB was very agitated and fighting with

Jail personnel. I observed that the prisoner had a "spit hood" over his head. I observed that his shoulders and his head were leaning against the back passenger door. I noticed that he was breathing very rapidly. The suspect appeared some what agitated. I could see that both his eyes were open even though his head was covered with the "spit-hood".

After a very brief conversation with Deputy Burton, Officers left our location and they were enroute to the PA Hospital.

I followed them a short time later to the Hospital. Before I've got to the Hospital Sgt Okeefe notified me via text that Officer Humphrys had notified him that their prisoner had "coded out", and that they were at NE Clackamas / NE 33rd. I immediately responded to the scene, and I assisted SE Sargeants to secure the crime scene.
