

SUMMARY:

Report on prisoner handled at MCDC intake sally port.

MENTIONED:

Officer Harley # 42860 (FTO)

ACTION TAKEN:

On 9/17/06 at approximately 1805 hours Officer Harley and I were leaving the MCDC booking area. On the way back to our vehicle, which was parked in the sally port, I observed a Patrol car with numerous MCSO Deputies attempting to remove a combative prisoner.

The prisoner was in the back of the marked patrol unit and appeared to be resisting officers attempts to remove him from the vehicle. I saw officers on both sides of the vehicle's rear doors, which were open. The prisoner was yelling and making a lot of noise and the deputies were having a difficult time getting the prisoner out.

When the prisoner was finally removed from the vehicle I saw that he came out feet first. When the prisoner was fully removed I saw that he had been hobbled and was wearing a spit shield. The hobble appeared to have been restraining the knees and was attached the back of the waist, not the handcuffs.

The prisoner was yelling at deputies take the cuffs off and for someone to help him. Four or more deputies carried the suspect into the booking area.

Given the circumstances I observed, at no time did I see any improper action on the part of officers involved with the prisoner

After the sally port was clear Officer Harley and I left.

Several hours later I found out the prisoner had died while being transported to the hospital. Sgt. Harrison was informed of the situation and I was instructed to write a special report regarding the incident.
