- I. Summary: On Sunday 09-17-06 at approximately 1810hrs Inmate Chasse was brought to MCDC and was combative. MCSO Medical staff looked at Chasse and determined that he needed to be taken to the hospital and he was taken out.

- III. Narrative: On Sunday 09-17-06 at approximately 1810hrs a Portland Police Officer and a MCSO Enforcement Deputy brought Inmate Chasse to MCDC. The arresting officers had called ahead and said that Chasse was combative and they needed help bringing him into Reception. Deputies Hubert, McElhaney and I went out into the vehicle sally port to help bring Chasse into Reception. Chasse was sitting in the back of their car with his hands cuffed behind his back and his ankles secured with a nylon hobble restraint. The PPB Officer unhooked Chasse's seatbelt and McElhaney started helping Chasse get his feet out of the right side of the car. Chasse started demanding that his handcuffs be removed. The Officers had told us that Chasse had bitten a PPB Sergeant and attempted to bite the PPB officer. Chasse had blood on his face and the PPB was worried that he would try and spit or bite one of us so I handed a spit sock to the MCSO Deputy to place over Chasse's head. McElhaney, Hubert, and the MCSO Deputy pulled Chasse from the car because he was not complying with their orders. Once out of the car McElhaney, Hubert, the MCSO Deputy, and I carried Chasse into an Isolation cell and placed him on the ground. While carrying Chasse in he was yelling and kicking at us. In the cell the MCSO Deputy and I held Chasse's legs while Hubert and McElhaney held his arms. At this time McElhaney cut the nylon restraint with a pair of scissors and then the PPB Officer removed the hand cuffs. During this time Chasse had been attempting to kick his legs and was grabbing McElhaney's hand. Chasse then stopped moving and every one backed out of the room. McElhaney and I rolled him on to his side and then left the room. Medical was called to look at Chasse. When Medical saw him they said that Chasse would need to go to the hospital. We then went back into the cell and Hubert secured Chasse with leg irons and handcuffs. McElhaney and the MCSO Deputy picked Chasse by the arms and Hubert and I grabbed his legs and we carried him out to the car and placed him in the back seat. Chasse was kicking and squirming while we carried him to the car. Chasse rolled off the seat on to the floor and the PPB Officer picked him up and placed him on the seat.
