RULE SUMMARY

The Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Systems Program is proposing to permanently amend and adopt Oregon Administrative Rules in chapter 333, division 250 relating to ambulance service agencies. Ambulance service agencies are often requested to provide transport to individuals suffering from a behavioral health crisis who are in custody or on diversion, often referred to as 'secure transport.' These rules address policy and education requirements that are necessary for an ambulance service agency to provide secure transport. Approval of secure transport providers are addressed in OAR 309-033-0432.

The Agency requests public comment on whether other options should be considered for achieving the rule's substantive goals while reducing negative economic impact of the rule on business.
