Quick FYI regarding Cedar Hills Hospital (inpatient psych). We have an FPS project in the pipeline that will take this hospital from 89 beds (current) to 97 beds (proposed) by converting 8 single rooms (current) to double-occupancy (proposed) with minimal construction.

We are in the early stages of our review (only the pre-design conference has been completed), but the design team wants to confirm that this bed increase is allowed under CN rules.

Per the design team, the provider believes that its CN approval was issued with a maximum % increase allowable each year and that this increase is within the margin. They would like to confirm.
