Last night, after being there for almost 12 hours and feeling isolated, she decided to turn on the TV in her room. It was set for a wrestling channel and the volume was pretty high. She'd didn't like the violence and the yelling.

However, the remote didn't work, so she was unable to change the channel, reduce the volume, or turn off the TV.

She told staff about it but nothing happened. When I arrived at 9:30 this morning the TV was still on. We could hardly hear each other talk. Staff had described her as "irritable" and this was likely the reason why.
