



AV has been in the psych unit for months per caller. AV reported on to Unity staff that while sitting in a chair a male patient put his hand up her shirt and sexually assaulted her by touching her breast. The male patient had only been on the unit for a few days. Caller is unaware of his past legal history except that he is on a forensic commitment. AV asked staff to call the "cops." The police refused to come to the unit unwilling to give up their guns. It is unclear when hospital staff called police. (It may have been after staff

reviewed the tapes a few hours after she initially reported the incident.) Initally, the staff thought she was alone in the TV room and did not seem to think there was evidence that what she said could have happened.

She went to her room for 20 minutes and came out again more calm. On at midnight she told another therapist that "a male patient had been touching her breast while she was here. The male patient also told her that he would kill her if she told on him." She then asked to speak to her doctor. Staff verbalized that she had a history of accusing males of sexual abuse. The staff then decided to look at the tapes. When they looked at the tapes, per the caller, they witnessed the male patient sexually touching AV. The police report has not been completed.
